In total, there are now 74 seminarians in formation training to minister for Irish dioceses, and these are: - 15 entering their Propaedeutic Year in various seminaries (Introductory Year) - 51 are studying in the national seminary of Saint Patrick's College, Maynooth, and at the Redemptoris Mater Seminary in Dundalk; and 8 are based in seminaries on the continent.
