### SOME CHANGES IN OUR FAMILY OF PARISHES FOR 2024:

The clergy of the Family of Parishes met last Tuesday to plan for the coming year. Changes are outlined below.

Masses will be shared in each Parish of the Family of Parishes from the 1st January 2024. This is already the practice in three of the five parishes. Each weekend in the newsletter you can see the intentions for every Mass. From 1st January 2024, Masses will be shared in the remaining two parishes. Schull & Goleen.

The Missa Pro Populo (Mass for the intentions of the People) will be celebrated in Durrus Church on a Wednesday morning at 9.00am, starting on Wednesday  $3^{rd}$  January. The 12noon Mass in Bantry can therefore be booked for shared intentions. The stipend of  $\epsilon$ 20 for the Missa Pro Populo Mass is taken from one parish each month. The month of December is the turn of Muintir Bhaire, in November it was Caheragh, in October it was Goleen and so on.

Maintenance of infrastructure continues to take its toll on parish finances. Each year the income for parishes continues to drop. When a parishioner dies, sadly there is no one to take their place. To help defray the cost of routine maintenance, there will be a monthly collection on the first Sunday of the month in Goleen, Caheragh & Muintir Bhaire Parishes. The monthly collection is already taking place in Schull and Bantry Parishes. Some parishioners make a weekly, or monthly contribution to their parish by direct debit. We thank those who contribute in this way. Others avail of the donate link for Schull Parish.

The Goleen donate link was discontinued this year as no one availed of this method of supporting the parish. I thank all our collectors, counters, Finance Committees and those who make the lodgements.

Over the past two years, the priests have moved from parish to parish to celebrate weekend Masses. As the years role on it will not be possible to have Mass in every Church every weekend. Major questions will have to be asked and unpopular decisions will have to be made. The diocese of Cork and Ross which is made up of 68 parishes has two students studying for the priesthood. The next ordination in our diocese will probably be 2030. That's 6 years' time.

During those six years, priests will retire and die. This family of 5 parishes will be lucky to have 2 priests in 6 years' time. A lot to ponder on.
