

There was great joy in St Mary's Church, Schull last Sunday morning as Mary Logan, Sacristan since 1988 was awarded the Bene Merenti Medal. The BENE MERENTI award is a papal honour, a medal presented by the Pope, recognizing exceptional service to the Catholic Church. The award has a history dating back to 1832, originally intended for soldiers in the Papal army.

BENE MERENTI MEDAL AWARDED

It's now a prestigious honour bestowed upon individuals who have demonstrated long and dedicated service to the church. The medal, featuring Christ on one side and the inscription Bene Merenti (well-deserving) on the other, is a symbol of distinction and gratitude for their contribution to the Church.

Fr Chris O'Donovan celebrated the Mass along with Fr Myles McSweeney and Fr Daithí Foley. The clergy spoke of Mary's faithfulness, daily dedication, and service to the priest's and people of Schull Parish. Through meticulous preparations every week, Mary has helped create the space where parishioners encounter the living God.

Mary has served on numerous Committee's in the parish including the Parish Pastoral Council, the Hall Committee, the Procession Committee and is a member of the current Parish Finance Committee.

Parishioners gathered in the Parish Hall after Mass to celebrate with Mary and her family. Wishing Mary many more years of dedicated service to Church.

Bantry Credit Union Annual Scholarship: Bantry Credit Union is now taking applications for the Third-Level Education Scholarship 2025. The scholarship is worth up to €10,000 (€2,500 a year for up to a maximum of four years). The scholarship is open to members or children of members of Bantry Credit Union as at 1 January 2025 who are entering third-level education this year for the first time.
