SOME CHANGES FOR 2025

December 8th, the Feast of the Immaculate Conception is traditionally associated with putting up Christmas decorations. It is one of five Holydays that we observe in the Liturgical year. This year the 8th of December falls on a Sunday and the second Sunday of Advent will take precedence over the feast. However, the feast will be transferred to Monday the 9th. Once a feast is transferred it loses its obligation. During the past few years attendance at Holydays has declined considerably. In our Family of Parishes, we have 12 Masses on Holydays. 2025 will see some changes to this schedule. At a recent meeting, the clergy of Bantry Family of Parishes discussed arrangements for Holydays. The meeting agreed to have two Masses in Bantry and one Mass in each of the other four parishes. The schedule will be as follows:

Vigil Masses: Bantry at 6.15pm and Lowertown at 8.00pm.

Masses on the Holyday will be: Schull at 10.30am, Kilcrohane at 11.30am, Bantry at 12noon & Caheragh at 7.00pm on the evening of the Feast Day. This schedule will come into operation on Jan 5th /6th, the Feast of The Epiphany.

Next year will see the introduction of Station Masses at weekend Masses. The parish of Schull has had this tradition for many years and has worked well. Therefore, we are introducing it to the other four parishes in our Family. Spring Station Masses will be on the weekend of March 22nd /23rd and Autumn Station Masses will be on the weekend of 27^{th} / 28^{th} September.

A complete list of second collections for 2025 will be printed in the newsletter at the end of the month.
